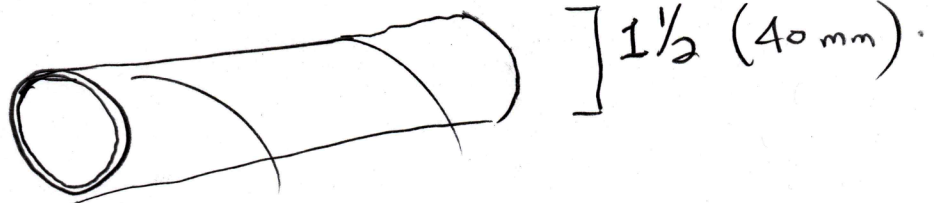


CUTTING UP YOUR TUBE FOR "CHICKEN MACHINE."

IDEALLY, A THICKER-WALLED TUBE, LIKE THE ONES IN PLASTIC WRAP CONTAINERS OR TIN FOIL, WORKS BEST.

BUT EVEN BETTER IS MAKING TUBES YOU CAN BUY FROM OFFICE SUPPLY STORES.



1 1/2 TO 2 INCH WIDE TUBES WORK GREAT.

* YOU NEED 3 SECTIONS *

FOR SUPPORT

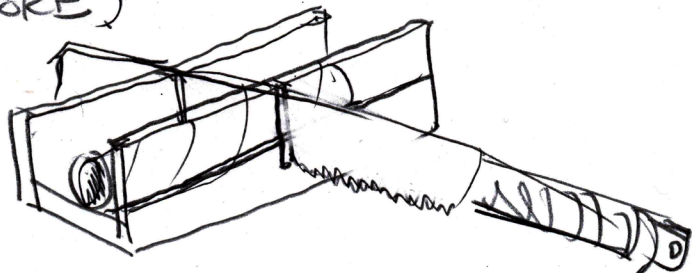


80 → 110 mm

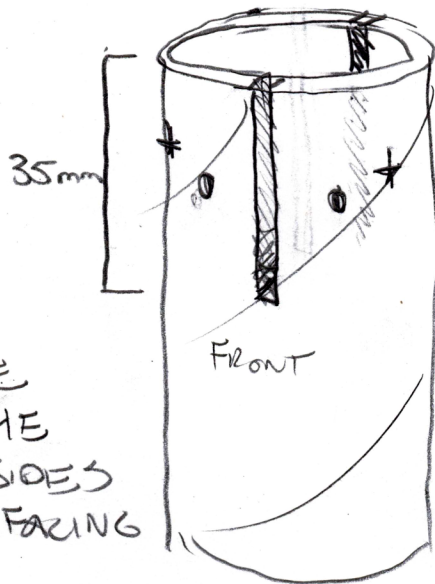
FOR CHICKEN BODY

— A TOTAL OF 150 mm FOR EACH BIRD —

USE A MITER BOX AND A FINE TOOTHED SAW TO CUT TO LENGTH (YOU CAN MAKE ONE OR PURCHASE FROM A HARDWARE STORE)



CHICKEN BODY DETAILS

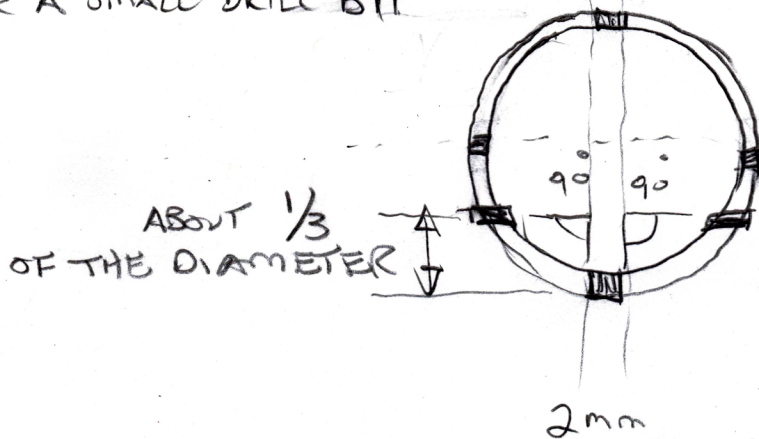


CUT SLOT
A LITTLE WIDER
THAN A COFFEE
STIR-STICK,
ABOUT 2mm WIDE,
& 35mm LONG,
HALF WAY ACROSS
THE DIAMETER OF
THE TUBE

* DRILL OR PORE
HOLE THROUGH THE
TUBE ON BOTH SIDES
OF THE 'FRONT' FACING
SLOT

YOU CAN USE A SHARP NAIL,
OR A SMALL DRILL BIT

- MARK WHERE
YOU WANT THE EYES
TO BE. THAT'S UP TO
YOU.



EYE HOLE?

* THESE TWO HOLES
MUST BE 90° TO THE
SLOT & EQUAL DISTANCES
FROM THE 'FRONT'
